Thank you to all who participated and to those who worked hard putting it all together.



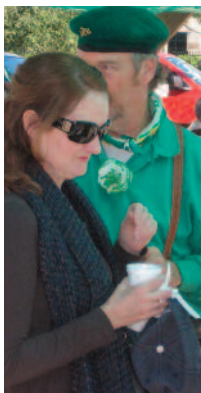
